

**Notice of Recount for the Office of President of the United States in the
November 8, 2016 General Election and Convening of the Dunn County

A recount of the votes cast at the November 8, 2016 General Election for the office of President of the United States will begin at the times and location set forth below:

Dunn County, Wisconsin – 9:00 a.m. on December 1, 2016, at the Dunn County Government Center, 800 Wilson Avenue Room 58 (lower level), Menomonie, WI 54751

The Dunn County Board of Canvass will convene on Thursday, December 1, 2016 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for the purpose of conducting the recount for the President of the United States in the November 8, 2016 General Election. The Dunn County Board of Canvass will recess as scheduled in the recount hours listed below with adjournment at the conclusion of the recount.

The scheduled hours of the recount are as follows until the completion of the recount or amendment of hours contained in this notice.

- Thursday, December 1, 2016 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Friday, December 2, 2016 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Monday, December 5, 2016 through Friday, December 9, 2016 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Monday, December 12, 2016 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Additional hours may be scheduled if required to complete the recount by the deadline of 8:00 p.m. on Monday, December 12, 2016 and will be posted at the Dunn County Government Center and published to the County Clerk's page on the Dunn County Website at www.co.dunn.wi.us.

The Dunn County Board of Canvass has selected to utilize optical scan tabulating equipment for tabulation of the recount of the Office of President of the United States in the November 8, 2016 General Election. A Public Test of the Equipment will be conducted by reporting unit prior to the start of tabulation for each reporting unit.
