

Criteria for Funding

The Community Resources and Tourism Committee consider several important factors when making decisions about funding. They fall into roughly three categories: Service, Organization, and Opportunity. The following factors are typical of those considered by the CRT Committee.

Service

The recipient of funding must provide a service or benefit to the citizens of Dunn County.

The service should be one that otherwise would not be available, or:

The service should be one that the agency can provide more efficiently or economically than can be provided by the county, or:

The service should be something that the county is not prepared to offer at the present time.

The service should be one that is not duplicative of currently available services.

Organization

The organization should be able to show evidence of broad based community support.

The organization should be able to show sustainability in the face of changes in management, direction, personnel, etc.

The organization should be able to show financial responsibility.

The organization must be able to show evidence of inclusivity and non-discrimination.

Opportunity

The requesting agency or organization should be able to demonstrate that the receipt of Dunn County funding will provide increased opportunity for the citizens of the county to see increased or improved opportunities in the realms of economics, education, well-being, human rights, and/or quality of life.
