



## Warm Up Your Winter!

**The Wisconsin Home Energy Assistance Program (WHEAP)** may help pay a portion of your home heating and/or electric costs. The 2016-17 Energy Assistance program runs from October 1, 2016 until May 15, 2017. If your household's 3 month gross income is below the following limits, you may qualify.
