

2016 Dunn County Highway Construction Projects

CTH Q Project (I-94 – USH 12 Knapp)

(Update 06-27-16)

The Dunn County Highway Department has completed the reconditioning project of CTH Q from I-94 to USH 12 in the Towns of Lucas & Stanton.

The reconditioning project consisted of clearing/grubbing, culvert replacements, ditching improvements, roadway widening, intersection improvements, adding base course, pulverizing existing roadway, grading, asphalt paving, shouldering, guardrail, and pavement markings. The new roadway consists of hot mix asphalt with 11ft. lanes, 4ft. paved shoulders, and 2ft. gravel shoulders.

CTH K Project (STH 64 – 1330th Ave.)

(Update 07-26-16)

Dunn County Highway is tentatively planning for asphalt paving on CTH K beginning the week of August 1, 2016. The new roadway will consist of 3.5 inches of hot mix asphalt with 11ft. lanes, 1ft. paved shoulders, and 3ft. gravel shoulders.

It is anticipated the roadway will be open to traffic during the paving process with temporary lane closures and traffic delays. If possible, please use alternate routes to minimize traffic impacts during construction. Individuals along this section of roadway will have access to their driveways during construction.

CTH E Project (Muddy Creek – CTH H)

(Update 07-26-16)

Dunn County Highway is tentatively planning to begin the reconstruction project of CTH E from Muddy Creek to CTH H beginning the week of August 1, 2016.

The reconstruction project will consist of clearing/grubbing, culvert replacements, ditching improvements, roadway widening, intersection/curve improvements, adding base course, pulverizing existing roadway, grading, asphalt paving, shouldering, and pavement markings. The new roadway will consist of hot mix asphalt with 11ft. lanes, 4ft. paved shoulders, and 2ft. gravel shoulders.

Landowners along this stretch of roadway should be advised that existing driveways will be constructed to match into the new roadway. Mailboxes that do not currently have the appropriate offset and height from the new roadway will be moved and relocated to meet current standards.

A signed detour will be implemented and this section of road will only be open to local traffic during construction. Individuals and businesses along this section of roadway will have access to their driveways during construction.
