

Outside Agency Funding Timeline

All dates subject to meeting schedules

May	Packets with all the materials necessary for application will be sent to past recipients and those requesting materials. A deadline for return of completed application materials will be included. If you have not previously applied for funding, or have not received a packet by June 1 st you may request the material by calling the UW-Extension office at 715 231-6694
Mid to late June	Opportunity for applicants to appear in person for presentation of funding requests to Community Resources and Tourism Committee.
Late June	CRTC review and decision on recommendations for funding, forward to Executive Committee for inclusion in draft budget
Early July	Opportunity for review of recommendations by the Executive Committee which has options for accepting, amending, deletion, or referral back to CRTC. If accepted by Executive Committee, recommended amounts become part of draft budget
July – Sept.	Potential reconsideration of grants recommendations by CRTC and/or Executive Committee. Once recommended by CRTC and accepted by Executive Committee, grant amounts are included in draft budget document*
October	Draft Budget, including CRTC recommendations for funding, presented to County Board
*November	Budget containing CRTC recommendations approved by County Board.

* Even after recommendation by the CRTC and acceptance by the Executive Committee grant amounts are not finalized until the County Board of Supervisors adopts the budget.

Tracking the status of budget requests

All meetings of the CRTC are open to the public. You can find meeting schedules and agendas on the Dunn County website. When decisions are made regarding funding they will be recorded in the minutes, which are also available on the website. Minutes are not official and might not appear on the website until approved by the committee at the subsequent meeting.

Meetings of the Executive Committee, it's agendas and minutes, are also open to the public and published on the Dunn County website. If there is no mention in the Executive Committee minutes of a particular funding request it means that there was no discussion of that item, which presumes that the CRTC recommendation stands.
