

PAYING FOR YOUR TICKET: If you wish to pay for your ticket **before your court date** you may do so. When sending payment, you must have your ticket number or case number on your check or money order.

If you are not required to appear for your ticket, and you choose not to appear, you will be found guilty by default. You will then be given an automatic 30 days to pay from your court date.

If you appear and cannot pay for your entire ticket that day you will be given 30 days to pay or you may complete a payment application agreement. If you qualify for a payment plan (*you must not have any outstanding debts owed to the Clerk of Court*), you will need to complete the form and return it to the Clerk of Court office. The form is available for you to print and complete, however, it will not take effect until signed by the Judge.

Payment by credit card is now available. You will need to contact the following toll free number 1-888-604-7888 or on-line at www.GovPayNOW.com and give them the amount you owe and your citation or case number. You will also need to know the pay location code of 2030. They will then contact our office and let us know when payment has been credited. There is a fee for this service and the process could take 2 to 3 business days.

All money will be applied to the oldest fines first.

PENALTIES FOR FAILURE TO PAY: If you fail to pay for your fine, any or all of the following may occur:

- A money judgment entered against you – and will show on your credit report
- A bench warrant
- Driving Privileges may be suspended for 2 years
- D.N.R. (hunting & fishing) privileges may be suspended
- Sentence to County Jail
- Assignment of income (wage withholding)
- Tax intercept
- Debt turned over to Collection Company & 12% interest charged
