


Looking Ahead to 2017

- ◆ Celebrated our 30th Anniversary on Wolske Bay!
- ◆ The Strategic Planning Retreat brought community members together to share their ideas on future services and programs
- ◆ Chippewa Valley Internetworking Consortium (CINC) installed fiber-optic increasing our internet capacity
- ◆ Began Wi-Fi Hotspots lending program
