## Veteran Discounts and ID's

With the Veteran's Day approaching our office is often asked what are the discounts available to Veteran's that day, and how does one prove that they are a Veteran?

The below link is a current list of all discounts provided to Veterans and Active Duty Military both on Veteran's Day and every day.

There are three ways to obtain a military/veteran ID:

Veterans Health Identification Card – This card is obtained by enrolling in the VA Health System

DoD ID Card – Available to retirees, 100% service connected Veterans and their family. To schedule an appointment, call 715-720-3400.

Veteran Stamp on Driver's License – "Veteran" can be added to your driver's license once Veteran status has been confirmed. To obtain complete the attached form and submit it to the Veteran Service Office.

### VA Benefits by Service Connected Rating

If you have a service connected disability, there may be additional benefits available to you based on the % of service connection.

0%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Free Glasses and Hearing Aids (There may be a co-pay for the appointment unless the Veteran is service connected for this issue)</li> <li>• Travel pay when attending VA appointments for the 0% service connected issue ONLY.</li> <li>• No co-pays for rated service connected disability appointments or medications</li> </ul>
10% 20%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Free Glasses and Hearing Aids</li> <li>• No co-pays for any VA appointments</li> <li>• Travel pay when attending VA appointments for service connected disability ONLY</li> </ul>
30% 40%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Free Glasses and Hearing Aids</li> <li>• No co-pays for any VA appointments</li> <li>• Travel pay when attending VA appointments</li> <li>• No co-pays for rated service connected disability medications</li> <li>• Potential dependent eligibility for WI GI Bill</li> </ul>
50% 60% 70% 80% 90%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Free Glasses and Hearing Aids</li> <li>• No co-pays for ANY VA appointments or medications</li> <li>• Travel pay when attending VA appointments</li> </ul>
70%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• VA Nursing home care at no cost at VA contracted locations</li> <li>• Discounted Resident Fishing License</li> </ul>
100%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Free Glasses and Hearing Aids</li> <li>• No co-pays for any VA appointments or medications</li> <li>• Travel pay when attending VA appointments</li> <li>• Potential dental benefits</li> <li>• WI Property Tax reimbursement (limits apply)</li> <li>• Dependent education assistance</li> </ul>


