




# CAPITAL

## AWARD

WisDOT Capital Funding Allocation \$332,200

Earmarked purchases; buses, passenger shelters and road signage. In four months two new buses in service.

Passenger shelters placements, sizes and design have been in review by community stakeholders and planning is moving forward.



## + SUSTAINABILTY

Low or No Emission Program (Low-No Program) 2018 Notice of Funding

To support the transition of the nation's transit fleet to the lowest polluting and most energy efficient transit vehicles. The Low-No Program provides funding to state and local governmental authorities for the purchase or lease of zero-emission and low-emission transit buses, including acquisition, construction, and leasing of required supporting facilities.



# COLLABORATION

Dunn County Economic Development Corporation

DCEDC recipient , Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development(DWD) grant, amount of \$244,813.

DWD, Commute to Careers, is targeted to plan and implement an affordable, self-sustaining, flexible transportation program that connects under-resourced workers to employment opportunities.

Together with Dunn County Transit, DCEDC submitted proposal to connect residents in the City of Menomonie to Menomonie Industrial Park and Stout Technology and Business Park.

Federal Formula Grant Program for Rural Areas (also called "Section 5311")

### How to ride

The Stout Route, Evening and Weekend routes operate according to schedule, for all other demand response service please call 715-235-7433 from 6:30am - 5:00pm, Monday through Friday.

### Regular Scheduled Service

Regular Scheduled Service in Menomonie

\$1.50	Per one way trip
\$4.00	For a day pass
\$45.00	For a monthly pass
\$0.75	For Elderly/Disabled off peak per trip
\$3.00	ADA Complimentary Zone Fare

### Demand Response Service

Menomonie demand response door to door

\$3.00	Per one way trip - (doorstep) for Elderly/Disabled
\$5.00	Rural to Menomonie - Per one way trip (includes Menomonie fares)
\$3.00	Rural Intercity - Per one way trip (Service within Rural Communities)
\$10.00	Agency supplemental fare for billed services - Menomonie
\$15.00	Agency supplemental fare for billed services - Rural
\$4.00	ADA Route Corridor


