

## Dunn County Sponsoring 2020 Deer Carcass Collection and Disposal

To help control the spread of CWD (Chronic Wasting Disease) during the fall deer hunt, the Dunn County Transfer Station will once again begin accepting deer carcasses and remains for proper disposal on October 5, 2020. A lined 20-yard dumpster will be onsite through December 31, 2020, after which deer carcasses and remains will no longer be accepted. There will be a disposal fee of \$5 per carcass or bag of remains to help offset the costs of disposal. Bulk carcasses must be weighed on the scale for a \$150/ton tipping fee, prorated to the pound. Deer carcasses and remains are not accepted at any of the Dunn County Area Collection Stations at any time, and are strictly prohibited in collection site compactors due to local landfill requirements.

The Dunn County Transfer Station & Recycling Center is located at E3900 State Highway 29, Menomonie, WI.
