Spring Conference

On Saturday April 2nd the Veterans Ministry Group will be hosting a conference on Moral Injury. Rick Rittmaster will be the main speaker and is an Army Chaplain, an ordained pastor in the Evangelical Lutheran Church of America, and a Licensed Professional Clinical Counselor. He works with Veterans diagnosed with PTSD, employing their spiritual strengths to mitigate the effects of trauma and moral injury sustained in combat. His experience in both the spiritual and psychological dimensions of trauma recovery offer important insights in addressing the debilitating effects of PTSD and moral injury.

There will also be breakout sessions on the "Military Mind/Family Impact" and Herbicide/Agent Orange presumptive conditions. Resource vendors will also be present. Attendance to this conference will be free of charge with refreshments provided.
